The European Centre for Career Development & Entrepreneurship offers you the chance to participate in an one-week intensive study program to work on your business idea under expert supervision.

Work with European entrepreneurs, academic experts and like-minded peers from Berlin, London, Milan, Madrid, and Paris. Your idea, our know-how: Let's get you on the road!

The 3rd International ECCE Summer School on Entrepreneurship in Europe will be held in Berlin, at the EBC Hochschule Campus Berlin, from the 1st to the 7th of July. The Workshops will focus on the key aspects that entrepreneurs must focus on when creating a new business: (a) communication & culture, (b) strategy, (c) marketing, (d) e-commerce & intellectual property, and (e) finance. All sessions will address the most relevant points that you must consider and how to apply them to your specific business idea. Additionally, you will work in groups with international peers on the refinement of your business plans, train your pitching skills in front of entrepreneurs and academics from all over Europe in order to be prepared to win the final business plan competition. Prize: Your very own European business mentor.

PROJECTS' SUBMISSION

Stage 1:

All students are required to submit a video lasting no longer than 5 minutes describing an Entrepreneurship Project. The video must be uploaded to YouTube (as a private video) and the relevant link must be emailed to: ecce.proyecto@uam.es

All students are responsible for checking in advance as to whether any materials in their project are covered by industrial or intellectual property rights, and if necessary they must organize to get permission to use these materials at their own expense. UAM and ECCE accept no liability for any violation of industrial or intellectual property rights by others taking part in the workshop or by third parties. By taking part in the workshop all participants undertake to keep secret and confidential the information provided by the other participants in relation to their projects, and not to appropriate it and use it as their own. Entrepreneurship projects at different development stages are welcome. Students from all academic backgrounds can apply, but you need to be from one of the ECCE institutions and team-applications are not possible.

SUBMISSION Deadline: 14th of March 2018

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER SUBMISSION?

Stage 2:

Each institution chooses the 5 most promising projects for participation (altogether 25 projects). We will inform applicants latest until **April 2nd** about the outcome of their application.

Stage 3:

The 25 projects will be shared amongst the successful applicants, who will have to decide on which projects they would like to work on during the summer school (you are not allowed to vote for yourself). The most popular five projects will be entered into the business plan competition and will be the main focus of attention during the group working sessions, notwithstanding the use of each participant's personal project to stimulate the development of each of the presented entrepreneurship ideas.

Participation in the summer school will be free of charge for all chosen projects. Additionally, all participants from outside Berlin will receive funding for travelling costs (up to 275 €) and free accommodation (bed in dormitory).
