REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION:

- Applicants must be in a proper employment relationship with a law faculty that is a member of the Erasmus program at the time they apply and this must continue at least until the end of the mobility visit.
- The prerequisite is prior agreement with the contact person in the relevant section of the partner university and agreement of the teaching visit
- Duration of visit: min. 2 days max. 2 months (to be agreed with the lecturer (Referent/Referentin) responsible)
- For visits of 2-7 days, at least 8 teaching hours (of 60 minutes each).
- The minimum number of teaching periods increases for longer visits. Ex: 10 days = 12 teaching hours, 12 days = 16 teaching hours
- PhD degree and at least 1 year teaching experience
- The lectures may be of bachelor, masters or PhD level
- The lectures may be given not only in English language but also in French or German.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

Please contact the Erasmus office of your home university for more accurate information. The documents required may change according to your university.

- Academic CV (only required on the first occasion)
- List of publications
- Evidence of teaching experience
- Staff Mobility Agreement for Teaching including the signatures from the home university (usually from the director of the institution or the Erasmus coordinator) and the Istanbul University (director of the institution or the Erasmus coordinator).
