Bucerius Law School is a private university founded by the ZEIT-Stiftung Ebelin und Gerd Bucerius with the right to award doctoral and postdoctoral degrees. The Law School has an excellent reputation, aiming to prepare its students for professional life within the international practice of law and business.

Each year, approximately 100 members of the Law School's tight-knit and carefully selected student body sit for the first state exam in law and complete their university studies with conferral of a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.).

Since 2006, Bucerius Law School has offered an interdisciplinary and international Master of Law and Business Program (LL.M./MLB). This program is hosted in close cooperation with WHU Otto Beisheim School of Management in Vallendar, Germany.

The future dean will be expected to:

- direct the Master of Law and Business Program
- lead coursework in English within the program (180 hours per year)
- develop new and innovative courses
- collaborate throughout the Law School
- take responsibility for recruiting, admission, student and alumni relations
- ensure the overall success of the MLB Program through close collaboration with its program directors (for the law and business components of the program) as well as its administrative director

To be eligible for this position, candidates should possess at the time of application:

- a Ph.D. (or equivalent int'l degree) OR a proven academic track record, preferably in the fields of law treated by the MLB Program

- a deep understanding of the common law system and at least a basic understanding of the German language
- a willingness to travel internationally with the intention of expanding the network of the program

Remuneration is based upon salary levels for professors in Germany. Recruitment for this position is subject to approval by the Hamburg Authority for Science, Research and Equality.

Bucerius strives to achieve equality between women and men in all areas of the Law School and strongly encourages qualified women to apply—these applications will be given preference where qualifications are equivalent to those from applications submitted by men. Bucerius Law School also sees itself as a family-friendly institution and advocates the compatibility of work and family. Additionally, it endeavors to employ more severely disabled individuals—their applications will also be given preference in case of equal qualification.
