MASTER EN DERECHO EMPRESARIAL

INTRODUCTION

The Master in Business Law comes as a response to the need to acquire knowledge to face the challenges increasingly difficult, which arise in the business world.

The main purpose of the Master is to offer high-quality training on the most complex aspects of the business. It is intended that students have the skills necessary to cope with difficulties that might arise with respect to the structure, government and corporate financing, either in their national side, as on the international level.

In this line, the Masters in Business Law has a highly multidisciplinary. Students will be approximated to the problems caused not only from the legal perspective (e.g., consideration of the business, labour, taxation, criminal and international), but also from the economic perspective (e.g., accounting and financial analysis, company valuation, etc...).

CONTENT

To obtain the official title in Master in Business



Law, students must take a total of 60 ECTS. These credits are distributed among four subjects of 12 ECTS each, and a thesis of 12 ECTS. The four subjects that make up the itinerary curriculum of the Master are:

- Government enterprises.
- Financing of enterprises.
- Mergers and acquisitions.

- Societies and international transactions.

Once these subjects students must submit the thesis. This will be carried out along the course under the guidance of a teacher of the Master and defend in a court for evaluation.

The Master of Business Law is made to be conducted in an academic year, full-time. However, students who wish to combine study with the exercise of professional activity can be done in two academic years, on a full-time to part-time.

The attendance is mandatory (minimum attendance: 80 by 100 school hours for each subject).

PROFESSOR AND PARTNERS

The Master is taught by professors and other teachers of the UAM specialists Law Company, as well as collaborators from the most prestigious law firms operating in our country and the judiciary (courts Commercial Madrid). Among the law firms include: Backer & McKenzie, and CMS Ballesteros Suarez de Lezo, Clifford Chance, Cuatrecasas, DLA-Piper, Garrigues, Gomez-Acebo and Pompo and Uria Menendez.



DOCTORATE

As an official title, students who complete the Master may continue their academic training, doing doctoral thesis at UAM.

REQUIREMENTS

University degree (BA, engineer, architect) .They are particularly suitable qualifications Bachelor of Laws, Bachelor of Economics, a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and Management and BA in Political Science.They can apply for the Master the rest of the graduates, but in such cases, admission is conditional on the assessment of the career of the candidate. Also, the Academic Council can authorize admission to follow certain courses of Bachelor of Law.

Fluency in written and spoken Spanish.

Have sufficient knowledge of English to sift through fluency in that language.
