ARRIVAL AT MADRID

How to get to UAM from the airport

At the airport, you need to take the commute train (Cercanías) at the Terminal 4 (T4). If you arrive in other terminals, you will find the free bus to the T4 at the exit.

From there, you catch the train, line **C1** (Bright blue line) in direction to Principe Rio. You will have to get off at Chamartin Station and take the **C4** line in direction to Cantoblanco Universidad station.

How to get to the city centre

In case you want to go to **Atocha station** from the airport, you need to take the C1 line train.

If you want to reach **Sol station**, you will have to take the C1 line and get off at Nuevos Ministerios. Then take either C3 or C4 line to Sol station. It takes 6 minutes walking to reach **TRYP Gran Vía Hotel** from Sol station, and 10 minutes to reach **TRYP Atocha Hotel**.

Please note that Line 8 from Metro service, that connects the airport with the city center, is temporarily closed due to renovation work.





HOW TO GET TO UAM

Rail

The best way to reach the UAM university campus is by using Madrid's commuter train network Cercanías. The C-4 rail line reaches the University (both C-4 A and C-4 B) with a frequency of between 5 and 10 minutes. From **Atocha Station**, it takes about 25 minutes, 20 minutes from **Sol Station** and 15 minutes from **Nuevos Ministerios station**.

You will have to get off at **Cantoblanco - Universidad.** The university campus is located right next to the station. It takes 10 minutes walking to get to the Rectorate Building from the station.

Bus
