

## Master's Degree in International Economics

### Academic Offer Course 2019/2020

#### Information

**Mandatory:** 39 ECTS credits

**Optional:** 15 ECTS

**Master's Final Thesis:** 6 ECTS

The Master's Degree in International Economics (60 ECTS) is delivered over a year (three consecutive semesters) where all subjects being quarterly.

In the third quarter, students will have to choose between the Professional Profile and Research Profile.

The first option has associated obligation to make Placement and the second option involves making the subject of Introduction to Research Techniques; both activities consist of 6 ECTS.

Additionally, students must prepare a Master's Thesis (6 ECTS credits).

**First quarter:** 5 compulsory subjects (18 ECTS)

**Second quarter:** 4 compulsory subjects (17 ECTS) + 1 optional (2 electives are offered to choose one elective. Each optional is 3 ECTS)

**Third quarter:** 1 compulsory course (4 ECTS) + 2 optional (3 optional are offered to choose 2. Each optional is 3 ECTS) + External practices or Introduction to Research techniques (6 ECTS) + Master Project (6 ECTS)
