

THE UNIVERSITY

The Universidad Autónoma de Madrid (UAM) is a public university that combines quality teaching, intensive research and a high level of employability with a strong social commitment.

UAM offer a complete university experience, with all kinds of services, including libraries, museums and some thirty sports facilities.

The Universidad Autónoma de Madrid is mostly located on **the Cantoblanco campus**, where most of the faculties are located and which is outside the city centre of Madrid. The Faculty of Medicine has its own campus and is also in the north of Madrid.







To get to the Cantoblanco campus (UAM) you can use both the bus and the train (Cercanías):

- ♣ By train: the Cercanías line that passes through Cantoblanco station is the C-4 (Parla-Atocha-Chamartín Cantoblanco-Alcobendas/ Cantoblanco-Colmenar Viejo). You can consult their timetables, stops and/or fares.
- ♣ By bus: the interurban lines that have bus stops on the same campus are: 714 (Plaza Castilla-UAM Universidad de Comillas), 827 (Canillejas-Alcobendas- UAM-Tres Cantos), 827A (SSReyes-Alcobendas-UAM) and 828 (Canillejas-Alcobendas-Universidad Autónoma). Lines 711, 712, 713, 716, 717, 721, 722, 724, 725, 726 and 876 stop near the campus. To consult the timetables of all these lines go to the Consorcio de Transportes website.









Transport

Madrid has an excellent public transportation system. In order to use it and buy monthly passes (abonos) you must apply for the public transport card of the Regional Transportation Consortium of Madrid.

The type of monthly pass that you need will depend on your age and in which town you live. Plesae note that the Cantoblanco campus of the **UAM** is located in the **B1** Zone.

The 30-day Youth Pass has a single rate of 20 euros for all the fare zones (you can travel from zone A to E2) and is valid until your 26th birthday.

Accomodation

UAM, through its International Reception Office, guides mobility students in their search for accommodation in Madrid.

Shared apartments, studios and rooms

UAM students can access accommodation offers in shared flats, studios or rooms in the center of Madrid and its surroundings.

Accommodation at the Cantoblanco Campus and Halls of Residence

On the Cantoblanco Campus there is the possibility of staying at the **Erasmus University Residence**.

Likewise, UAM has a **Residence Hall**: the <u>CM Mayor Juan Luis Vives</u>, close to Plaza de Castilla and well connected to the Campus.

Other private Residence Halls attached to the UAM:

- Santillana University College (Male)
- Somosierra University College (Female)

"Living together" program (Programa "Convive")

It is a program in which students from universities in Madrid live together with older people, thus creating an enriching meeting and exchange space for both parties.

UAM has signed several collaboration agreements with private companies that facilitate the search for accommodation for students who wish to rent a flat.

Another option is accommodation in an off-campus student residence or renting a room in private homes.

Language courses

At UAM, international students can benefit from a 50% reduction in the enrolment fee for the **Spanish course for international students**, offered by the Language Service. The cost would be 65EUR for the first semester. For the second semester the cost will be 130EUR (no reduction applies).

These courses are fully covered for EUROSUD students who, if interested, must enrol and pay for the language course, and then request reimbursement from us.

The <u>other language courses</u> such as English, French, Italian and Portuguese cost 260EUR per year (no reduction applies). Please note that these courses are only offered annually, so students coming to UAM during their second semester will not be able to take them.

In addition, the Faculty of Philosophy and Arts offers courses in Turkish, Persian and Arabic. Those enrolled in EUROSUD can attend **as listeners**, during the official timetable.

If you are interested in these courses, we recommend that you inform us well in advance so that we can send the information to the lecturers of these courses.
