

The UAM: according to international rankings, the best Spanish university; 26,000 students, 2500 professors, and a spacious campus located outside the city. The Faculty of Economics and Business: one of the most prestigious national centres; 6000 students, nearly 300 professors and a wide range of academic study programmes at undergraduate and postgraduate level with up to 11 specialized university-specific degrees.

Welcome to one of the best Economics Faculties in Spain. In this video, academic administrators will tell you about the study programmes we offer and the advantages of studying with us.

Each year, approximately 1000 new students enter our Faculty, distributed among the many degree programmes we offer—Economics, Business Administration and Management, Tourism...

Although the campus is located a few kilometres outside Madrid, this does not mean we are isolated.

You can live on campus. The Erasmo Residence Hall provides housing for 423 students and Faculty members.

The UAM also has extensive sports installations. Our student body includes top athletes selected for the DAN programme.

In addition to its extensive academic offerings, the UAM offers a wide variety of athletic activities. Over 36 sports are taught at a basic level, and you can compete on both university and Spanish federation teams.

The University organizes cultural activities throughout the year: a lecture cycle on contemporary issues in the humanities during the academic year and summer courses in the Residencia la Cristalera in Miraflores de la Sierra. One of the most important cultural engagements is the UAM's concert season.



Learning and perfecting languages is essential in the world of the university. The UAM's language service offers courses in English, French, German and Italian, as well as Spanish for foreigners.

Sometimes when I go to the UAM, I speak Italian, sometimes English. Now I'm learning German!

In the Office of Solidarity Action and Cooperation, we work to promote values, volunteer commitment, and integrated university training.

The most popular degrees in our Faculty are Business Administration and Management and Economics. Each degree is structured into 4 years that include internships in firms. You can study either mornings or afternoons. Every year, we receive approximately 300 new students in each degree programme.

In conjunction with the Law Faculty, we offer a double degree in Law and Business. The study programme takes 6 years and can be pursued through either morning or afternoon study.

The Faculty has already planned its entrance into the European Higher Education Space. This involves the use of new teaching methodologies based on lifelong learning, smaller groups of students, follow-up tutorials, etc. We are making a tremendous effort to transform classroom dynamics in order to train the best professionals.

There are fewer students this academic year, more participatory classes, and continuous evaluation. We students must work from the first day of class, and professors evaluate our performance throughout the year, not only on the final exam.

After the 2nd year, you can enrol in the Educational Cooperation Programme —one semester of theory plus one of internships. This programme is more demanding, but it enables us to access the labour market under better conditions than other students.



Our library has one of the best Economics collections in Madrid, with approximately 90,000 volumes. 10,000 of these are student textbooks. We also have 7000 specialized scientific journals. The library reading rooms have a total of 211 seats and are open Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.

The practical content of many subjects can only be explained using new technologies. We have 6 computer labs with 156 stations where students can access Internet and the computer programmes used on the market.

The University gives professors access to web pages that support teaching. It provides student email accounts and wireless connections throughout University buildings. All information related to the Faculty's regular activity is posted on our webpage: study programmes, class schedules, room assignments, calendar of exams, access to student transcripts...

Our Faculty participates in international mobility programmes worldwide: the United States, Canada, Australia, Europe, Latin America...

The Erasmus programme is a unique opportunity to study in Europe. At the University of Rotterdam, I not only enriched my education but learned the meaning of "Europe".

The Erasmus-Socrates programme is without doubt the European Union's most important mobility programme. Every year, we send approximately 250 students to different universities and receive around 300.

The Faculty's academic offerings include double degrees in BAM and Economics with the University of Paris Dauphine.

Internships in firms add a practical complement to university training. The Faculty provides an internship office that facilitates students' entrance into the labour market.

This office coordinates finding internships for over 600 students a year in a great variety of companies in Madrid. Students can apply the knowledge acquired in the Faculty and develop their abilities in the work world.

Every student has an academic advisor who evaluates and mentors us during the internships.

The Faculty offers excellent postgraduate study programmes. There are two kinds of postgraduate programme: official and university-specific. The official programmes lead to the official title of Master. The specific programmes carry the recognition and prestige of the UAM.

The official Master's degrees have a double purpose: professional and academic. Students who complete an official Master's are in a better position to access the labour market or begin a research career in one of the doctoral programmes.

A total of 6000 students live and work together daily, sharing our campus. They are supported by a staff of 290 professors with a real vocation for teaching and research. Add to this the dedication of the 55 staff members who compose the administrative and service personnel of our Faculty.
