During two weeks, participants will have the chance to get an insightful overview on the latest developments and trends in the field of Banking and Finance from a European perspective. The programme combines classroom sessions, bank visits, cultural activities and – as the name betrays- some optional sport activities. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a certification equivalent to **5 or 7.5 ECTS**(for 7.5 ECTS an additional essay is required).
