The objective of this call is to promote the incorporation of Spanish and foreign research personnel with outstanding track records into research organisations such as UAM. Note that these are **tenure-track position** with the commitment to open a permanent position right after the five years of the fellowship.

The DFT offers a vibrant research and teaching environment covering theoretical and experimental particle physics, nuclear physics, galactic and extragalactic astrophysics, and cosmology.
