| Visa and resident permit | <p>Students from outside EU need a long stay student visa when staying for over 3 months in France. The student visa must be obtained before arriving in France. Students must contact the closest Consulate General of France.</p> <p>EU citizens and those from countries within the Schengen area do not need a visa or a resident permit. However, citizens from outside Schengen area wanting to find a job while studying must have a residence permit.</p> |
