Health insurance	Having a valid health insurance in Italy is essential to request a residency permit. If you have already stipulated an insurance policy in your country of origin and it was validated by the Italian representation before you left, you can use it for the first issue of your residency permit. Otherwise, after arriving in Italy you will have two opportunities: either registering with the National Health Service (SSN) or stipulating a private policy.
Visa	Depending on the duration of the stay, students from non-European countries must possess a visa to study in Italy. Tor Vergata International Student Mobility Office sends the Invitation Letter to the Partner University’s International Office for visa application. With the Invitation Letter, the Incoming student can apply to the Italian Consulate for the Visa. We suggest to ask also for the “codice fiscale”, necessary for the enrollment at the University.
