- Existence of a bilateral exchange agreement between your university or school and the HEIG-VD in your field of study.
- Official nomination by your home institution to our RI Center, within the following deadlines:
 - for the fall semester: until April 30.
 - for the spring semester: until November 30,
- Suitable language level: courses are given in French, a B2 level is required.

Applications and deadlines

Once the RI Center receives the official nomination from your home institution, a link is sent to your personal email address. It is advisable to regularly check the spam or junk mail folders of your email box.

We invite you to follow it in order to submit your application online within the given deadlines:

- for the fall semester: May 31,



- study contract (Learning Agreement),
- report cards,
- RESUME,
- ID photo,
- copy of an identity document,
- proof of language level (French B2).

Scholarships

Study contract

Before your arrival, you must establish a study contract mentioning the courses you plan to take at HEIG-VD. When choosing courses, it is important to avoid scheduling conflicts.

Your signed study contract must be sent to the RI Center at: international@heig-vd.ch

Before your arrival in Yverdon-les-Bains, your study contract must absolutely be signed:

- by yourself,
- by your home institution,
- by the person in charge of the sector in which you will take your courses (before your arrival, it is the RI Center which takes care of obtaining this signature for you).

Changes after your arrival:

If you need to make changes to your study contract after your arrival (overlap of courses, canceled course, etc.), contact the person responsible for the course in which you are taking courses. She will have to validate the changes and sign the document:

- your published study contract must be validated and signed by your home university,
- a copy must be given to each party, including the RI Center.
