COURSE CATALOGUE:

UCU proposes a wide range of courses to choose from the Course Catalogue in English or menu of UCU degree programs in Ukrainian.

The new Course Catalogue is issued every year by the end of May (updates are possible prior to the beginning of each semester).

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS:

Most classes are taught in Ukrainian, some courses are taught in English. Students who are choosing courses in Ukrainian are required to have at least B2 level. Students who are choosing courses in English and are non-native speakers of English are required to have at least B2 level.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Students should first be nominated as an Erasmus+ student by the home university. Nominations are welcome by email (tomkiv@ucu.edu.ua/ international@ucu.edu.ua) by 15 June for the Fall semester and by 15 November for the Spring semester.

The nomination information should contain:

- name of the nominee(s)
- study program / study cycle / year of study
- date of birth
- period of stay
- student's contact e-mail

APPLICATION DEADLINE


To be considered for admission, all required application documents must be submitted by the following deadlines:

- 15 June – for the Fall semester
- 15 November – for the Spring semester

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Once we receive the nomination from the partner university, we will ask the nominated student(s) to fill in **the online application form** and submit the following documents:

- copy of the first page of the international passport
- official transcript of records
- motivation letter (max 500 words)
- Erasmus+ **Learning Agreement**
- proof of the language proficiency

Orientation Program ----->

For the exchange students, an Orientation program is organized (optional). During the one-week program which is held prior to the beginning of the semester, students receive important information about studying at UCU and staying in Lviv.

The Orientation program includes:

- ice-breaking meeting
- first steps in the city with UCU Buddy
- guided city tour to the most popular and outstanding places in Lviv region
- survival Ukrainian language course.

**The Orientation program fee of 100 EUR is optional.*

Language Courses ----->

UCU School of Ukrainian Language and Culture offers semester course in Ukrainian Language of different levels – from the absolute beginner to advanced. UCU Center for Modern Foreign Languages offers semester courses in the following languages: English, German, French, Polish, Italian, Spanish. Transcript of Records ----->

The official Transcript of Records along with the Erasmus+ Certificate of Attendance are issued upon completion of the study program at UCU within the three weeks period.

4. HOUSING AND ACCOMMODATION

The international students have two basic options – living at the **UCU Guest House** or searching for the private accommodation.

Most of the UCU international students live at the UCU Guest House located on the fifth floor of the Collegium, the university dormitory. →

Housing Information

Amenities:

- single or twin rooms
- each room is fully furnished and has a separate bathroom and WC, refrigerator, towels and free Wi-Fi access
- bedding and bedclothes are included
- the kitchen of common use (without cooking) on the floor with a microwave, kettle, kitchen utensils and drinking water
- the cost for the single stay in the twin room is 2100 UAH (approximately 65-70 EUR) per month
