Nomination

Partner universities are required to nominate their students by completing [this form](#). It will be available only during the corresponding nomination periods:

- **1 March – 30 April:** for students whose mobility at UB begins in **July**
- **1 September – 30 October:** for students whose mobility at UB begins in **February**

Application

The nominees will be contacted and asked to send the application documents. If accepted, they will receive an admission letter for visa purposes.

Application Documents

- Registration form
- Résumé or CV
- Cover letter
- Letter of recommendation by a professor
- Updated academic transcript
- Copy of valid passport

Language Requirement

Courses are taught in Spanish, except for the PALAS Program, which is taught in English. A B1 - B2 (CEFR) level is recommended, although an official certificate is not required. Rather, we trust our partners' selection criteria.

Credits

Instead of a credit system, the UB adopts a system based on contact hours. The final equivalence is left for the home universities to decide.

Grades

The grading scale goes from 1 to 10, with 10 being the highest score. 4 is the passing grade.

Academic transcripts

Once students finish their corresponding exams, home universities will be forwarded the students' academic transcript. If the student is a free mover, the transcript will be sent directly to their email.
