Academic calendar

It is divided in two terms:

- **Fall (1st Semester)**
September – January*
- **Spring (2nd Semester)**
February– June*

Each term consists of 16-17 weeks of classes and 2 weeks for the exams. **Orientation days** are planned to welcome exchange students at the beginning of each term. Attendance to these sessions is compulsory.

Credit system

Credit Transfer (CT) are a standard means for comparing the volume of learning based on the defined learning outcomes and their associated workload for higher education across UMY. Certificate of completion and academic transcript are awarded in the end of the period.

Exchange Programme:

The Credits Systems depends on the program that you will take each department or program usually only provide you maximum 18 credits of 24 of each term.

Full Time Programme:

In this program, you are allowed to take maximum 24 credits of 24 for each term.

Usual workload

Exchange Programme:

36 Credits per year – 18 Credits per term

Full Time Programme:

48 Credits per year – 24 Credits per term

The UMY grading system is based on a scale from A to E, where B is the minimum passing mark

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Visa

Students have to apply for a student visa. Please note that a tourist visa is not enough to stay in Indonesia for over one month.

For full-time Student (4 years) and Exchange Program (6 months-1 year)

Students have to choose a Limited Stay Permit Visa (ITAS). The Process to require ITAS that are:

1. UMY Proposes the Student Permit to the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research and Technology
2. UMY Proposes the Student Visa through the Directorate General of Immigration of Indonesia
3. After receiving VISA, students are permitted to go to Indonesia and obligated to report to the Immigration Office of Yogyakarta.

For Exchange Program (3-6 months)

The visa used for the student who stays only for 3-6 months is Social Cultural Visa (VKSB). Process for acquiring the VKSB only needs to bring the recommendation letter and letter of acceptance from UMY to Indonesian Embassy in their country. VKSB can be valid until 6-months maximum but it must be extended every month.

Housing

The University provides free accommodation at the University Residence for all International Students. Student who takes Full Time Study with UMY scholarship, the dormitory will free for one year. The cost of off-campus accommodation varies, depending on the facilities available.

UMY will pair a local student with an international student to assist with such things as dorm check-in, enrolment, general class registration, and other essential activities. Private Overseas Insurance

All foreign students need to purchase their own overseas insurance, which includes health and accident coverage for the study period, in their home country before departure. UMY only provides clinic for small injuries.

Yogyakarta (simply called as Jogja) is located on the heartland of island of Java, Yogyakarta is the only province in Indonesia that is still governed by a monarch.
