A PATHWAY TO YOUR SUCCESS

Puente a la UAM is designed to support international students in preparing to meet the **admission requirements** of the Autonomous University of Madrid (UAM).

This year-long program (September 2026 – May 2027) combines intensive Spanish language instruction with preparatory courses that equip students to successfully complete the specific exams (PCEs) required for admission to Bachelor degree programs.

Once your **Spanish level** is assessed, you'll be placed in a **14-hour-per-week intensive language** course combined with PCE preparation courses. By the end of the program, you'll reach a **B2 level in Spanish** and develop a deeper appreciation of Spanish culture and university life.

Students are guided by expert lecturers and supported throughout their adaptation process to the Spanish university system.


HOW DO I APPLY?

- 1)Complete the online application form
- 2) Submit the required documents
- 3)Contact studyabroad@uam.es to schedule your Spanish language placement test
- 4)Receive your admission offer and request your student visa appointment at the Spanish consulate closest to you.
- 5)Arrange housing before coming to Madrid (contact studyabroad@uam.es if you need assistance)

While participation in the Puente Program helps students prepare for university studies, admission to a Bachelor's program is subject to the university's standard requirements.

Timeline for admission to Bachelor degrees

- One year in advance, gather all necessary documents, have them translated and apostilled
- ·Recommendation: Use <u>Homologation Student Services</u> or similar services
- Dates for the PCE specific exams are in May and June
- Apply to any of the public universities of Madrid through the **DUM platform** in early June
