Puente a la UAM is designed to support international students in preparing to meet the **admission requirements** of the Autonomous University of Madrid (UAM).

This year-long program combines intensive Spanish language instruction with advanced courses, ensuring a strong academic foundation for future graduate study.

Once your Spanish level is assessed, you'll be placed in a 14-hour-per-week intensive language course.

By the end of the program, you'll reach a **B2/C1 level in Spanish** (recognized for admission by the Center for Graduate Studies at UAM).

HOW DO I APPLY?

- 1)Complete the online application form
- 2)Submit the required documents
- 3)Contact studyabroad@uam.es to schedule your Spanish language placement test
- 4)Make the reservation payment (1200.- €)
- 5)Receive your admission offer and request your student visa appointment at the Spanish consulate closest to you.
- 6)Arrange housing before coming to Madrid (contact studyabroad@uam.es if you need assistance)

Students, admitted into the Puente a la UAM Program can apply for early conditional admission in a Master's degree at UAM.

While participation in the Puente Program helps students prepare for university studies, admission to a Master's degree is subject to the university standard requirements.

Documents required for applications to Master's degrees:

Passport or national ID and Curriculum Vitae (CV).

Bachelor's / Undergraduate / Licentiate degree certificate officially translated and apostilled

Academic transcript with grades from your Bachelor's / Undergraduate / Licentiate studies.
