BUN!:Bibliographic search



This is the search engine for the bibliographic resources offered by the library. It launches its search on the printed or electronic collection. The materials are books, journals, articles, book chapters, conference proceedings...





Bun! has two search options: simple and advanced.




Simple search

We can introduce a search term, a word or several words, a phrase, a name... it will search for matches from a global perspective.



We can adjust our query using the filters on the left







- You can save your query.
- Personalise your results and help us provide you better result matches disciplines. Please select up to 5 disciplines.







Bun! Bibliographic search

By default the search engine launches a global search over all bibliographic collections and resources.







You can choose whether you want to search in a single collection.



You can choose on which type of documents you want to launch the search.

Advanced Search

It allows us to combine different parameters that we are interested










From the main page of Bun! you can access a menu with different options. One of them is **Recommended Bibliography by Subjects**






















3. Click on the title of the record:

Available at: It tells us in which library the book is available and its location.





If there are few copies, you can request a purchase from the library.

Loans procedure Week (8 dsys) + 5 renewals= 40 days Long (15 days)+ 5 renewals= 75 days






Personal profile: Loans and Requests of items.






Economics Library: spaces and equipments

Printed Collection

Reference **Handbooks**

- They are recommended by your Lecturers.
- All of them are available and classified by Universal Decimal Classification

New **Books**

- Specialised books published from 2015 onwards, topic collections (Entrepreneurship, Languages, Asia Collection, Books in Chinese), leisure collections (Literature, Tourist Guides, cinema and Economics), the last 5 years of journals and reference works.
- All of them are available and classified by Journal of Economic Literature (J.E.L.) Classification

restricted access

- Specialised items published before 2015, journals before last 5 years, **Statistical Documentation Centre and European Documentation Centre** items, research papers, working papers, audiovisual collection, old items Restricted access, on request over the counter.
- Special materials such as laptops, calculators, mobile phone chargers, USB drives, markers, mouses, etc
- All of them are available

Self-loan

Electronic Collection

It is composed of Databases, e-journals and e-books

Weekly Loan: Handbooks, Dictionaries, Laptops, Recommended Bibliographic by subjects Long Loan: Rest of items

Room or daily Loan: Non-bibliographic materials, old items, journals and research papers
